

RAIL FENCE STARS

58 x 66 Patriotic Quilt with Simple Applique



Ever want a fun, relaxing and easy project? Well this one is a great all-around quilt that can even be used as a QOV (assuming you follow their guidelines).

There is a lot of room for adding your own flair, or just leave this project plain as it shows great beauty in its simplicity.

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FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

This quilt only takes 3 fabrics—Red, White and Blue
 I chose to use a Crinkle/ type red, white on white
 star for the white, and a crinkle/type blue. These
 choices provided just enough texture for interest but
 let the colors stand on their own.

There is no manufacturer information as I chose
 these from my stash and am not affiliated with any
 fabric company at this time.

The **Applique Block** is 8x8 (7.5 x 7.5 finished)

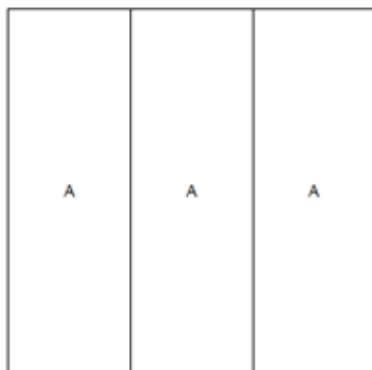


Fabric width 44-45 inches	Number of patches	Yardage estimate
	39	# 1 + 3/8
	46	# 1 + 3/4
	46	# 1 + 5/8

The estimate for this fabric assumes that long strips ARE pieced.

BLOCKS (42 total 6x7):

- A. Rail Fence Block—35 blocks
This block is flipped alternately to create the rail fence look.
- A. Blue block with Star Applique—7 blocks
Feel free to use a template for applique or even redesign the block for paper piecing. You could also embroider your star too if you want—it's your quilt!

BORDERS:

- Border 1: (2) 53 x 3.5 Red and (2) 51.5 x 3.5 Red (3" finished)
- Border 2: (2) 59 x 3.5 White and 57.5 x 3.5 White (3" finished)
- **I used the blue to complete the quilt as binding.

***NOTE: Borders are always your choice, make them any size you desire!
